Car Parking

Following on from last week's guidance on safe and considerate parking around the school, the Police have asked that we remind families about the following points:

- Parking a sufficient distance from the junction(s), so as not to hinder motorist/pedestrian visibility (10m).
- Not to obstruct the footpath in such a way as to prevent persons in wheelchairs, pushchairs etc, from getting passed.
- Not obstructing dropped kerbs, driveways or pedestrian crossings.
- Not parking on restrictions such as yellow zigzag lines.

Thank you for your support in keeping the roads around our school safe.
