Considerate and Safe Parking

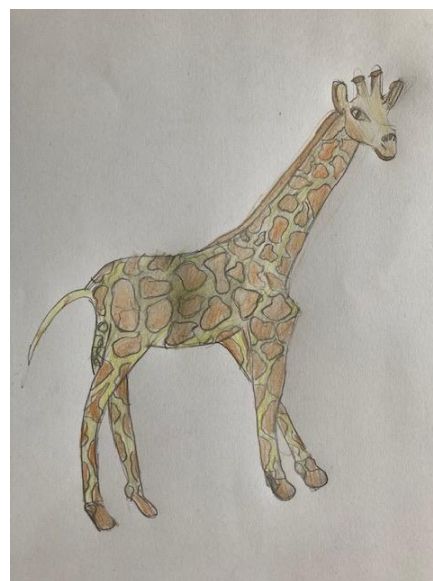
